LAWMO Receives \$160K Mental Health Grant



Legal Aid is the proud recipient of a generous \$160,116 grant from the <u>Health Care</u> <u>Foundation of Greater Kansas City</u> (HCF) to fund our Mental Healthcare Access Project. Legal Aid and HCF are partnering to help clients experiencing mental illness secure public benefits by supporting a full-time attorney who provides representation, brief legal advice, and counsel. The grant is part of the \$4.45 million awarded to 28 nonprofit organizations through HCF's 2018 Mental Health funding. HCF received a total of 74 proposals totaling nearly \$15 million in requests.
