HELP MAY BE AVAILABLE



You and your children have special rights at school if you are:

- Staying temporarily with someone else because you lost your housing
- Staying in a motel, trailer park or campground
- Staying outside or in a place that's not meant for sleeping
- Staying in poor housing that does not have utilities such as water, electricity or heat
- Staying in a shelter or in a car



Those rights include:

- Staying in the same school, even if you move, and receiving transportation to that school, as long as it's in the student's best interest
- Enrolling in school immediately, without the documents schools usually require
- Receiving free school meals
- Getting help with school supplies and other needs
- Extra support for youth who are on their own
- Help connecting young children with early childhood services



Contact your local school district administration and ask to speak to the McKinney-Vento Liaison to find out if you qualify for help.
