The Partnership

The Governor's Faith-Based and Community Service Partnership for Disaster Recovery was created by an executive order issued by Gov. Mel Carnahan after the Great Flood of 1993 to improve the coordination of response to the overwhelming human needs caused by that event. The Partnership was reaffirmed by **Executive Order 09-25** in September.



The Executive Order has 8 duties and responsibilities:

One is to serve as the coordinating organization in concert with the State Emergency Management Agency for emergency human services functions in natural disasters.

The Partnership Mission

The mission of the Governor's Faith-Based and Community Service Partnership for Disaster Recovery (The Partnership) is to aid Missourians' recovery plans by developing and implementing a holistic approach to disaster recovery, maximizing public and private resources to facilitate an efficient and effective integrated system addressing human services, housing, infrastructure, community and economic development issues

Vision Statement of The Partnership

The Partnership acts to enhance Missouri's ability to plan and prepare for, mitigate against, respond to and recover from any disaster so that all Missourians, directly or indirectly affected, may be associated and empowered in their recovery.

Standard Operating Guidelines (SOG)

- Recovery (the Partnership) has created LEHDCOM to address the legal services needs of disaster survivors.
- LEHDCOM operates in all four phases of the emergency management cycle:
 - a. Mitigation
 - b. Preparedness

- c. Response
- d. Recovery

Standard Operating Guidelines (SOG)

1. Mitigation: LEHDCOM will undertake projects that reduce the legal risks to which disaster survivors are vulnerable. Community disaster education of those who are vulnerable to disasters and the resultant potential legal consequences is one such project.

- a. Capacity and resource development
- b. Planning
- c. Training
- d. Exercises (if offered and appropriate

2. Preparedness: LEHDCOM will engage in the following preparedness activities

- **3.** Response: LEHDCOM will respond during disasters.
- a. The Partnership and/or SEMA and LEHDCOM will determine the need to activate the LEHDCOM to coordinate response activities based upon the following:
- b. 1. Needs expressed by Partnership and Missouri Voluntary Organizations Active in Disaster (MO VOAD)
 - 2. Needs expressed by affected communities
 - **3.** Calls and information received by LEHDCOM members.
 - 4. If activation is required, SEMA will coordinate with the LEHDCOM leadership to determine the date time and type of meeting or conference call.

- 4. Recovery: LEHDCOM will continue to support legal help to disaster survivors during the recovery
